NO.ELD.1093/CR-2230/NRG-2 :- In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 5-A of the Bombay Electricity Duty Act, 1958 (Bombay XL of 1958) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Maharashtra, hereby exempts from the 1st day of July 1993, the consumption of energy in respect of any industrial purpose in the whole of the State of Maharashtra from payment of the whole the electricity duty payable under part-F of the schedule to the said Act, subject to the following conditions.namely :-

- i) The exemption shall be available only in respect of energy generated in a generating station installed on or after the 1st day of July 1993 by the person carrying on the industry and consumed by himself for such industry.
- ii) The exemption shall not be available in respect of any energy consumed for residential or office purpose in any industry.
