Duties of Chief Electrical Inspector:

The Chief Electrical Inspector is the head of the department and is responsible to the State Government for efficient working.

The Chief Electrical Inspector shall:

- 1. Maintain coordination with State Government/ Other state governments/ Government organizations, Central Electricity Authority in respect of Electrical Safety programs and power issues.
- 2. Implement and execute the schemes by the department for electrical safety in the public interest.
- 3. Encourage the unemployed youth for entrepreneurship by facilitating Electrical contractor /Supervisor/ Wireman license issued by the department.
- 4. Provide technical guidance and guidance for supervision for ensuring the quality of inspection.
- 5. Ensure co-ordination of activities of different wings of the department.
- 6. The Chief Electrical Inspector exercises control over the performance of all the subordinate staff of the department.
- 7. The duties are similar to electrical inspector in nature as inspection of electrical installation is concerned. The inspection of new electrical installation having voltage 400KV and above, conventional generating units above 500 MW, renewable energy generating units above 500 MW and their periodical inspection is carried out by the Chief Electrical Inspector or by the subordinate officers as per the direction.
- 8. He also performs as Appellate authority under section 127 of Electricity act 2003 for the EHV consumers.
